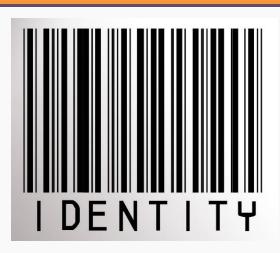


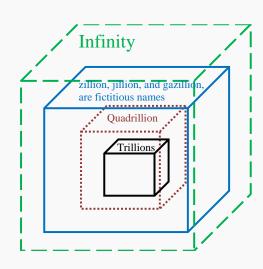

- > Thought process

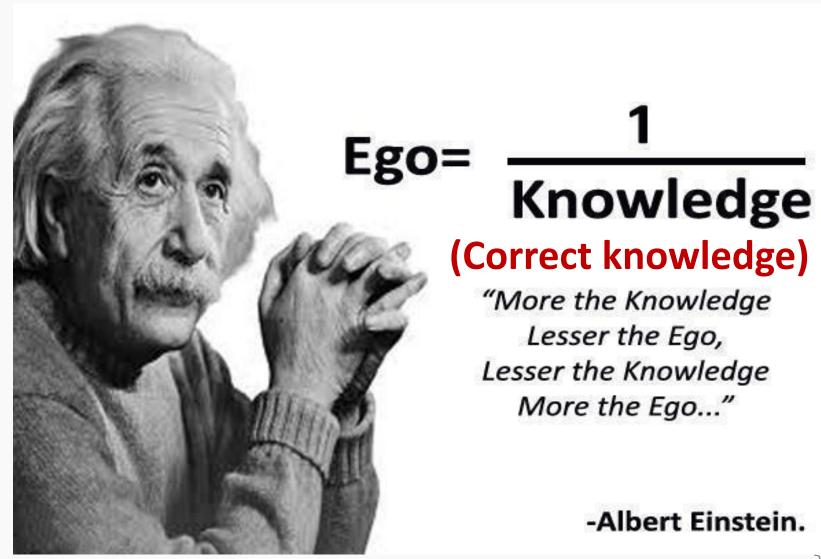












Rene Descartes: "I think, therefore I am"

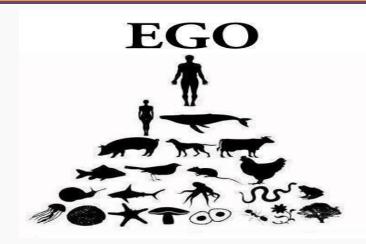
Cognitive power - True self - Seed of Enlightenment
